ENERGY MISSISSIPPI AWARDS A
2007 COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP GRANT
TO THE ARTS COUNCIL'S
PEARL RIVER ECOSYSTEM MURAL VIDEO PROJECT
AT CLINTON JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The Arts Council of Clinton, Inc. has been awarded a \$1,000.00 grant from Entergy Mississippi to develop a video project in conjunction with the Pearl River Ecosystem Mural. The mural project will take place on October 19-21, and will be directed by artist Robin Whitfield and painted by art and science students in the Science Hall of Clinton Junior High School, located at 711 Lakeview Drive.

Well-known videographer Anthony Thaxton will follow and capture on film the student's activities as they travel to the Mississippi Museum of Natural Science, where they will view the Pearl River firsthand and learn about the plant and animal life that exists in and around the River. Thaxton will accompany the students back to Clinton Junior High School and will film them over the next day and a half as they plan, create, and install the 24 foot by 8 foot mural. The Pearl River Ecosystem Mural Video will be placed in the Clinton Junior High School library and, in conjunction with the mural, will serve current and future teachers and students as a teaching/learning tool about the Pearl River, a major endangered waterway that flows through Jackson, MS. The video will also serve as a permanent record of the development and implementation of the mural project.
